#### General Directions

- 1. CUT SHEETS:** Cut out the sheets of Fast2Fuse and use your iron (set to "Steam") to separate the Fast2Fuse.
- 2. FUSE EASY SIDE:** Press carefully, pressing about one-third of the way down the sheet. Press fabric edge side up one strip of Fast2Fuse and press with a cool, dry iron for 5 seconds.
- 3. FUSE:** Press fabric edge down with Fast2Fuse.



- 4. FUSE SECOND SIDE:** Press carefully under the second piece of fabric and up off the Fast2Fuse. Press with a hot, dry iron for 5 seconds.
- 5. TRIM:** Trim around piece of fabric away from edge of Fast2Fuse.

- 6. FINAL WARNING:** Please don't use a hot iron and steam for 10 seconds or continuously for Fast2Fuse. Fast2Fuse will separate under such pressure. Only use hot iron and steam for 10 seconds or continuously for the second piece of fabric on the Fast2Fuse.

Projects made with Fast2Fuse can be reworked washed in cold water, and tumble dry on low heat. Store Fast2Fuse in a cool, dry place. Roll, do not fold, for storage.
